

# THE ANCIENT ORDER SET UP QUEEN MARIE ANTOINETTE

●The name "Voltaire" is "volt" and "air". French writer FRANCOIS VOLTAIRE was named after the ANCIENT ORDER's Laser Ray system of controlling others with electromagnetic waves without their knowledge. Voltaire was born in 1694, nearly 100 years before the French Revolution.

●QUEEN MARIE ANTOINETTE was executed during the French Revolution or "re"- "volt". It was the ANCIENT ORDER using this "volt" and "air" system who brought about the French Revolution and named it after the "volt".

●As further proof, note the literary work FRANKENSTEIN, the monster that was brought to life by volts of electricity during a lightning storm. FRANKENSTEIN was written by British writer MARY SHELLEY. She died in 1851.

●In the 1790's: the French Revolution("re"- "volt"). Between 1790 and 1850(just 60 years), the work FRANKENSTEIN, about a monster brought to life from the dead by volts of electricity from the air during a storm.

●FRANKENSTEIN is the ANCIENT ORDER's book. Mary Shelley has many of the ANCIENT ORDER's number and letter codes in her name, the same as QUEEN MARIE ANTOINETTE. Notice the name "Marie", for instance. It is "Mr." and "A, I, E". "Marie" / "Mr. A, I, E" / "mystery". The ANCIENT ORDER use the name "Marie" as a code for the word "mystery". But that is Marie Antoinette's name. What about the woman who wrote FRANKENSTEIN?

● MARY WOLLSTONECRAFT SHELLEY  
M Y S T E R Y = MYSTERY

●MARY WOLLSTONECRAFT SHELLEY has the word "mystery" in her name and it's in a straight line. That is why both her first and last names end in "y".

●FRANKENSTEIN is just one of many common historical references which prove this Laser Ray system is hundreds of years old. Voltaire in the 1690's and 1700's. Then in the 1800's a monster brought to life by volts of electricity in the air during a lightning storm.

●A guillotine is used to cut off a person's head. It was named after J.I. GUILLOTIN, born in 1738. The guillotine was invented after 1750 and was the newest method of execution in Queen Marie Antoinette's lifetime.

●The ANCIENT ORDER had researched a new device to kill people. They needed a name for it. They found a name which sounded like the word "guile", which means to trick or skillfully deceive. That was the name of Dr. J.I. Guillotin and that was why the guillotine was named after him. The execution device guillotine comes from the word "guile", which means "treacherous cunning" and "skillful deceit."

●The ANCIENT ORDER invented the guillotine, named it after a doctor, had it accepted by the public and then used it to kill Queen Marie Antoinette, who had no idea she was being watched and set up to have her own head cut off by the ANCIENT ORDER's trickery, deceit, guile...:"guillotine".

Vol-taire (vól-tár', vól-). François Marie Arouet. 1694-1778. French philosopher and writer.

Shel-ley (shél'è). Mary Godwin Wollstonecraft. 1797-1851. British writer.
